## Jackie Chan Challenge Cup Hong Kong Universities Rowing Championships 2017

#### 1 Events and Entries

##### 1.1 Event

Categories	8+	4+	4-	4x	2x	1x
Regular event	M & W	M & W	-	-	M & W	M & W
Trial event	-	-	M & W	M	-	-
Alumni event	M & W	-	-	-	-	-

- 1.2 Race distance of regular events and trial events is 2000m. Race distance of alumni M8+ is 2000m. Race distance of alumni W8+ is 1000m.
- 1.3 For regular events, each university shall enroll up to two entries in each event.
- 1.4 For trial events, each university shall enroll up to one entry in each event.
- 1.5 For alumni events, each university shall enroll up to two entries in each event.
- 1.6 Each rower shall participate in up to a maximum two events.
- 1.7 For all events, there must be at least two crews taking part.
- 1.8 Alumni event shall not be counted in pointing system and shall not be regarded as either regular events or trial events, otherwise no marks will be given.
- 1.9 It is advised to make up the entries with reference to the Preliminary Schedule, especially for participants intending to double up on entries. The published order of racing will not be changed to allow for any double entries which involve time clashes.

## 2 Eligibility of Rowers

- 2.1 A student studying full time post-secondary education programs in Hong Kong during the immediate past academic year; and
- 2.2 Registered rower of the Hong Kong, China Rowing Association.

## 3 Eligibility of Coxswains

- 3.1 Registered rower of the Hong Kong, China Rowing Association.
- 3.2 Coxswains shall be weighed wearing racing uniform on tested scales not less than one hour and not more than two hours before their first race in each event in which they are competing on each day of competition.
- 3.3 The minimum weight for a coxswain (wearing racing uniform) is 50 kg for men's events and 40 kg for women's events. (To make up this weight, a coxswain may carry additional deadweight as close as practicable to his person in the boat. No article of racing equipment shall be considered as part of this deadweight.)

## 4 Regulation

- 4.1 Each rower (including coxswains) should be able to present his/her HKCRA membership card and his/her student ID card (except coxswains) for competition.
- 4.2 Please renew the Centre Users' status by 27<sup>th</sup> July 2017 (Thursday) before 5pm, otherwise, he/she will not be able to race in The 23rd Hong Kong Universities Rowing Championships 2017.
- 4.3 Each competitor shall be responsible for his own health and fitness and able to swim for 50 metres in light clothing.

## 5 Rules of Racing

The races shall be conducted in accordance with the Rules of Racing of the Hong Kong, China Rowing Association (Please refer to [http://www.rowing.org.hk/wp-content/uploads/2017/03/ROR2017\\_C.pdf](http://www.rowing.org.hk/wp-content/uploads/2017/03/ROR2017_C.pdf)).

## 6 Entry Procedures

- 6.1 Teams interested in taking part in this race should complete the enclosed Entry Form, and submit by e-mail to Ms. LI Yin Wai (twentythreeurc@gmail.com) ***on or before 13<sup>th</sup> July 2017 (5pm) / on or before 20<sup>th</sup> July 2017 (5pm) (for alumni event only)***.
- 6.2 Late entries will only be considered subject to the number of entries in that event and the final decision of the Organizing Committee. Late entries shall be subject to double entry fee. **Late Entries Deadline for regular and trial event: 20<sup>th</sup> July 2017 (5pm)**, entries after the late entries deadline will not be entertained.
- 6.3 Incomplete entry forms and telephone entries will not be accepted, and such entries will not be further processed. All teams should confirm their entries after submission of their entry forms. Organizing Committee would not bear the responsibility of any missed mail, fax, e-

mail or hardcopy.

## 7 Withdrawal

- 7.1 If a crew withdraws from an Event for which it has been entered, it shall give notice on the designated form to the Organizing Committee as early as possible, at the latest, it shall give notice of withdrawal no later than one hour before the first heat of the Event. For any withdrawals received after this time, except when accompanied by a medical certificate, the Club/ Registered Organizations/ Crew shall pay a penalty equal to the entry fee. In the case of a withdrawal the Organizing Committee may conduct a new draw if required.
- 7.2 A withdrawal once made is irrevocable. There shall be no refund of entry fees.

## 8 Crew Changes Before the First Heat

- 8.1 Crews – Clubs and Registered Organizations may substitute up to one half the number of rowers (as well as the coxswain, if applicable) in any crews entered by them, provided that the substitutes are members of the same Club/ Registered Organizations and the changes are advised in writing to the Organizing Committee at least 1 hour before the start of the Heat concerned.
- 8.2 Illness or injury – In the case of illness or injury to a member of a crew before the first heat, a substitution may be made if the Organizing Committee is satisfied that the nature of the illness or injury is such to prevent the rower from competing. Such a substituted rower may not compete again on the same day, but may compete in a later round of the same Event on the following day subject to the Organizing Committee being satisfied that the reason for the substitution and reinstatement was genuinely related to the illness or injury and the rower's recovery.
- 8.3 Single scullers – No substitute is permitted for a single sculler.

## 9 Boats and Oars

- 9.1 All competitors must use private boats for competition.

## 10 Prizes

- 10.1 There would be no entry point for each participant.
- 10.2 Points are awarded to finalists only. The point scheme applies to all events except invitation race and the distribution is as follow:

Place	1 <sup>st</sup>	2 <sup>nd</sup>	3 <sup>rd</sup>	4 <sup>th</sup>	5 <sup>th</sup>	6 <sup>th</sup>
Points	21	13	8	5	3	2

- 10.3 The points will be accumulated for calculating the overall results of

- Overall Champion;

- Overall 1st Runner-up;
- Overall 2nd Runner-up;
- Men's Overall Champion; and
- Women's Overall Champion.

## **11 Entry Fees**

11.1 Entry Fees - HK\$90/entry

11.2 Double entry fee will be charged for all late applications under the condition (6.2)

11.3 Entry Fee should be paid to Organizing Committee on or before Entry Deadline.
