- 1.1.To enhance rowing standard among schools by providing opportunities for students to compete with each other and make friends in the Championships.
- 1.2.To promote rowing in school by encouraging schools setting up school rowing team.

## **3.Rules of Racing**

- 3.1. "Rules of Racing" of Hong Kong, China Rowing Association (HKCRA) will be used in this Championships, details please visit: <u>http://www.rowing.org.hk/wp-content/uploads/2020/06/HKCRA\_Rules-of-Racing-and-related-By-Laws-Version-2020.pdf</u>.
- 3.2.Open event can consist of crews from different schools, age group (range 14-19) or gender (at least 1 female in each crew), however the results **will not be** counted in the overall points system.

## 4.Eligibility and Notice to Rowers

- 4.1. Rowers must be under 19 years old. (Valid Student Card should be presented during registration)
- 4.2.Entries must be endorsed by the respective school.
- 4.3. Rowers must be the students of the school in the current year 2022-2023.
- 4.4.Rowers must be able to swim at least 50 meters with clothes.
- 4.5. Rowers must have Star 3 qualification or above issued by HKCRA or equivalent rowing qualification.
- 4.6.Each rower can <u>only participate in maximum 2 different events</u>, and <u>cannot participate in more than one</u> <u>age group</u>. Open event are not limited
- 4.7.If there are excessive of entries in any event, participating schools can only enter <u>one crew</u> of that event.
- 4.8.HKCRA reserved the right to cancel if there are less than 3 participating crews and from less than 2 different schools.
- 4.9.Coxswain can be a non student, and allow to participate in any age category



# **5.Age Group**

According to the Hong Kong Schools Sports Federation (HKSSF), the students' age grouping of 2022-23 are as follows: -

Secondary School	B Grade	Under 16 – Date of birth on after 1 January 2007
	C Grade	Under 14 – Date of birth on after 1 January 2009
Primary School	A Grade	Under 13 – Date of birth on after 1 January 2010

## **6.Application Procedure**

6.1. The completed Entry Form **(Annex 1)**, Declaration **(Annex 2)** and entry fee (paid via cheque or ATM) should return to the HKCRA by email (irene.q@rowing.org.hk), post or in person. ## 6.3. Deadline of Entry: 24<sup>th</sup> October 2022 (Mon)

6.4. Payment method:

- By cheque : payable to "Hong Kong, China Rowing Association" with the school name written on the backside. Or;
- Via ATM : please transfer the entry fee to the HSBC account: 002-6-187443, and write the school name on the bank-in-slip, email to (<u>irene.q@rowing.org.hk</u>) or fax to the HKCRA. (Fax no. 2601 4477)
- 6.5. The HKCRA will only process the application with completed entry form and full payment of the entry fee. The applicant should contact the HKCRA to re-confirm if your application is duly received.

## 7.Points System and Prizes

7.1.Trophies for the "Overall Champion, 1<sup>st</sup> runner-up and 2<sup>nd</sup> runner-up for Men's Events and Women's Events" will be presented to the <u>Secondary Schools</u> according to the points they gained. Points will be awarded as shown below:
