Sha Tin Rowing Centre Extension Project – Update Report

Thank you for your continued support to the Sha Tin Rowing Centre and Jockey Club Shek Mun Rowing Centre. The Hong Kong, China Rowing Association (HKCRA) has been working tirelessly to promote rowing to the community of Hong Kong. Perhaps the most important part of our efforts is enhancing the overall levels of participation, and this will be greatly supported by the expansion and renovation of the Sha Tin Rowing Centre.

Funded by the Hong Kong Jockey Club Charities Trust, the construction of Sha Tin Rowing Centre (STRC) was completed in 1985 and is now 37 years old. While it has served the rowing community very well over many years, the ageing facilities no longer provide an ideal environment for rowing activities. The HKCRA determined that action was needed to ensure the long-term sustainable provision of rowing at STRC. Thanks to the strong support of the Trust, the extension project of STRC began in early 2021 and the completion is forecast for the 1st quarter of 2023.

The new facilities will be able to host more rowers, as well as provide greater comfort and accessibility for our users. In addition to more boat storage, the extension project will add an extra floor level which will provide an increase in functional space and training-related areas.
