3. ELIGIBILITY & RACE FORMAT BY EVENT

Please note the following eligibility requirements and details for each event category.

3.1 International Small Boats Championship Time Trial Format

All rowers are eligible to enter this Time Trial in their appropriate category. There is no entry fee for the Time Trial. For this event only, every rower will compete in their individual capacity under their name and nationality only, not in the name of their Club. Each rower may only enter for one Time Trial category. The Time Trials will be scheduled as the first events of the Championships. (Note: No 2- boats are available for rental for this event – see para. 9.(4).)

Every sculler/crew will row one 2,000m time trial, starting at approximately 30-second intervals. The time trial results will provide an overall ranking for all competitors (regardless of category) and medals awarded for each category.

3.2 Open Events

- (1) Open Events are open to all rowers in their correct category.
- (2) Each rower can only enter a <u>maximum of one event from Group 1 and one event from Group 2</u> of the Open Events. Groups are as follows:

*Open Group 1	*Open Group 2

(3) Progression in Open Events -

Case 1 Up to 6 entries: direct Final.

- Case 2 7–12 entries: 2 heats; Heat winners to Final; 2nd, 3rd and 4th placed crews in each Heat go to one Repechage, other crews eliminated; the first 4 crews in Repechage go forward to Final.
- Case 3 13–18 entries: 3 heats; Heat winners to Final; 2nd and 3rd placed crews in each Heat go to one Repechage, other crews eliminated; the first 3 crews in Repechage go forward to Final.

There will be no Final B race for these events.

If the event has 19 entries or more, the progression will be issued separately.

3.3 University Challenge Eights

Rowers entering the University Challenge should be a student studying full-time post-secondary education programs during the current year or immediate past academic year.

3.4 Under-19 Events

- (1) Under-19 Events are restricted to rowers who must be 18 years of age or below at 31 December 2023. There is no age restriction for coxswains.
- (2) If there are more entries than the number of lanes or available boats, progression for U-19 events will be through Heats and Final with the highest ranked crews in the Heats proceeding to the Final. The number of crews progressing to the Final from each Heat will depend on the number of entries.

3.5 Corporate and Disciplined Services Cups

- (1) Rowers must be current serving members of the respective Disciplined Service or current employees of the company respectively.
- (2) If there are more entries than the number of lanes or available boats, progression for Corporate and Disciplined Services events will be through Heats and Final with the highest ranked crews in the Heats proceeding to the Final. The number of crews progressing to the Final from each Heat will depend on the number of entries.

3.6 Masters Events

(1) Each Masters rower can only <u>enter</u> a maximum of one age category in the same boat class AND can only enter <u>a maximum of one event from Group 3 and one event from Group 4</u>. Groups are as follows:

NOTE: Any Masters rowers entering both Open and Masters events do so at their own risk. The schedule will not be changed to allow for rowers entering in both categories.

(2) All rowers and crews entering Masters events must comply with the correct age category as follows:-

Masters A - Minimum age : 27 years

Masters B - Average age : 36 years or above

Masters C - Average age : 43 years or above

Masters D - Average age : 50 years or above Masters E - Average age : 55 years or above

Masters F - Average age : 60 years or above

Masters G - Average age : 65 years or above

- Masters H Average age : 70 years or above
- Age categories do not apply to coxswains.
- (3) Masters races of different age categories may be combined and medals will be awarded for each age category in the combined race.
- (4) Every Masters rower must be in a position to prove their age by presenting a valid identification document.

3.7 Para-Rowing Events

- (1) Para classification categories follow those of World Rowing Para Classification Regulations (World Rowing Rules Appendix 15) where applicable.
- (2) Gender –

<u>Para Mixed events</u> - half of the rowers in a crew shall be men and half shall be women (excluding coxswain).

Para Open events - crews may comprise any combination of men and/or women rowers.

Р 2 2	(1) By submitting their entry, each competitor confirms that they understand and agree to abide by the

- (1) By submitting their entry, each competitor confirms that they understand and agree to abide by the HKCRA Rules of Racing and Competition Notice. Anyone who does not meet the qualifications or does not comply with the requirements of the competition, or violates the Rules of Racing, whether before, during or after the competition, may be excluded from an Event and any fees shall not be refunded.
- (2) Coxswains must be weighed with racing uniform on tested scales <u>not more than two hours and not</u> <u>less than one hour before the start time of their first race</u> in each event on each day of racing. The coxswain may be of either gender.
- (3) Race uniform should be identical within a crew. Local Clubs should wear the uniform registered with the HKCRA.

8. HEALTH AND FITNESS / INSURANCE

- (1) Each participant shall be responsible for their own health and fitness to enter and compete in the Championships. All competitors shall be able to swim at least 50 metres in light clothing.
- (2) All Overseas Teams must arrange their own personal accident insurance.

9. BOATS AND OARS RENTAL

- (1) All competitors should use their own equipment for the Championships. Rental boats will only be available to Clubs and teams which do not have sufficient equipment of their own.
- (2) A limited number of boats and oars are available for rent and teams wishing to rent equipment should submit the Equipment Rental Online Form on or before 27 October 2023 (Friday) before 12:00 noon (HK Time). The payment request will be issued via PayPal once all request details are confirmed. Boat Rental Form: <u>https://reurl.cc/V4EV6A</u>
- (3) Teams using rental boats and/or oars shall be responsible for all repair or replacement charges incurred from any equipment damage and replacement parts resulting from their use.
- (4) There will be NO Coxless Pairs (2-) available for rental. If you wish to race the 2- in the International Small Boat Championship event (Time Trial format), you should arrange your own boat.

10. MEDALS AND TROPHIES

- Gold, silver and bronze medals will be presented to the first three crews in each event and category respectively, subject to the following Special Note -
 - SPECIAL NOTE:

*Where only 3 crews compete in an event, only gold and silver medals will be presented.

*Where only 2 crews compete in an event, only the gold medal will be presented.

*The EXCEPTIONS to this will be Corporate and Disciplined Services events where all medals will be presented; and Masters events where in the case of 1 entry, the gold medal will still be presented.

- (2) Trophies shall be awarded in designated events as shown on the Start List.
- (3) Certain trophies are retained by the HKCRA as perpetual trophies. Such trophies will be presented and returned for engraving and display at the Rowing Centre.

11. ACCOMMODATION AND TRANSPORT

(For Overseas Teams Only)

- (1) Overseas teams shall be responsible for their own accommodation and transport.
- (2) There are several hotels in the Sha Tin area which are easily accessible to both Rowing Centres.
- (3) Public transport is very convenient between Sha Tin and the urban areas.
- (4) Teams requiring further advice on either accommodation or transport matters (including transport of oars) should contact the OC at hkrc@rowing.org.hk.

12. WEATHER

Hong Kong's climate is sub-tropical. During the time of the Regatta, the weather is expected to be rather dry and temperature is generally in the range of 24° C to 28° C.

45th Hong Kong Rowing Championships, 11-12 November 2023

Terms and Conditions of Entry

By entering the 45th Hong Kong Rowing Championships (the Event), each competitor, or in the case of a Junior (U-19) rower their parent or guardian on their behalf, agrees to the following Terms and Conditions which shall apply to all activities associated with the Event, including training and racing :-

- 1. The participant or their parent/guardian declares that the participant has full knowledge of the risks involved in water sports and rowing and is well prepared, physically and sufficiently fit to compete in the Event.
- 2. The participant or their parent/guardian declares that the participant can swim at least 50 metres and is confident under water & treading water in clothing not less than racing uniform and attire. Otherwise the participant agrees that they shall be responsible to wear a personal flotation device (pfd) at all times when they are in the boat for the purposes of the Event, whether for training or racing.
- 3. The participant or their parent/guardian hereby indemnifies the Hong Kong, China Rowing Association (HKCRA), the Culture, Sports and Tourism Bureau (CSTB), the Leisure & Cultural Services Department (LCSD), the Supporting Organisations and the appointed officials, volunteers, staff & employees and shall not hold them liable for any claim or demand arising from the death, personal injury, damage or loss of property of the participant or their Club whereby such is not caused by negligence, which may occur in the course of or as a result of participation in the Event.
- 4. The participant or their parent/guardian agrees that the participant is entering the Event at his/her own risk and responsibility. The participant discharges the HKCRA, CSTB, LCSD and all other individuals and organisations connected directly or indirectly with the Event from any responsibility in the event of injury, death or loss of property incurred during, as consequence of, or while traveling to and from the Event.
- 5. The participant or their parent/guardian agrees that the participant shall comply strictly with all rules, regulations, requirements & instructions related to the Event and the participant shall be responsible for any death, personal injury or loss to property if such is caused by the violation of such rules, regulations, requirements & instructions by the participant.
- 6. The participant or their parent/guardian agrees to pay the costs of repair or replacement for any damages to any equipment caused by the participant.

Medical Declaration: It is the participant or their parent's/guardian's responsibility to make known any potential medical conditions that may affect their health, safety and performance during the Event and related activities and to inform HKCRA, CSTB and LCSD of any subsequent conditions arising from or becoming known during or after the Event.

7. By entering the Event, the participant or parent/guardian agrees to and confirms to accept and follow all of the terms, conditions and points made and subsequently raised in these Terms and Conditions, in the Event Bulletin, the Notice to Competitors, the Rules of Racing and the Team Managers Meeting.
