REGULATIONS AND ELIGIBILITY

5. GENERAL RULES

- (1) All rules and regulations will follow the Rules of Racing of the HKCRA except as specified on the "Notice for Competitors" of the event;
- (2) Age Groups The age of a competitor shall be his/her age on the date of the event in which he/she is competing (either 24th or 25th February 2024). The competitors of all individual age-group events must enroll according to their age group;
- (3) Only Men may enter a Men's event and only Women may enter a Women's event;
- (4) Mixed Events In the mixed event (except Para-rowing) half of the team shall be women and half shall be men. In the Para mixed team one of the rowers shall be a woman;
- (5) Lightweight Events Rowers entering lightweight events must meet the maximum weight limits. The maximum weight limit for individual lightweight men is 75 kg and for individual lightweight women is 61.5 kg (competitors should wear the racing uniform for weigh-in).;
 - * Lightweight event competitors must weigh in not more than 2 hours and not less than 1 hour before the scheduled start time of their event.
 - * If the competitor does not meet the weight limits, or do not weigh in at the specified period, they shall be excluded from that event (entry fee will not be refunded);
- (6) Team Relay Events In Team Relay events, each team shall use one machine with all team members rowing in turn. Every rower in each team shall row the exact distance (or time) specified for each rower in that event. When the rower reaches the specified changeover point, the next rower in the team must take over within 2 strokes. If any rower fails to row the correct distance or does not change at the specified point the team may be excluded.
 - The result of each team will be determined by the total time taken by the team to complete the required distance including the changeover between the rowers. The fastest team is the winner. In the case of relay events for a fixed time, the team rowing the longest distance in the specified time is the winner;
- (7) Individual Races Cut-off Time In order to ensure all subsequent races can start on time, the Organising Committee (OC) reserves the right to stop a race if any rower's race time is likely to exceed 10 minutes when the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd placed rowers have already finished the race;
- (8) Correct Entry Information OC reserves the right to verify the identification document and exclude from an event any competitor who submits false or invalid information;

- (9) <u>Compliance with Rules</u> By submitting their entry, each competitor confirms that he/she understands and agrees to comply with the Rules of Racing and all additional requirements and information in the Race Bulletin. Any rower who does not meet the qualifications, does not comply with the requirements of the competition, or violates the Rules of Racing or other requirements, whether before, during or after the competition, may be excluded from an event (entry fee will not be refunded).
- (10) Rowing Machines Concept 2 (Model D) Rowing Machines supplied by the OC will be used for all events. Competitors may set the resistance setting of their choice only before the start of the race, but no adjustment is permitted after the race has started. In the case of a relay event, such adjustment may be made at the same time as the crew change but not at any other time during a Race. Rowers shall use the machine allocated to them;
- (11) <u>HKCRA Right to use Images</u> The HKCRA and the OC reserves the right to take videos and photographs of all competitors before, during and after their race and to use such videos and photographs for marketing, promotional and educational purposes. Copyright owned by HKCRA.

6. ELIGIBILITY

(1) TOP OF THE TOPS - PRESIDENT CUP (Invitation Event - no entry fee)

- 1. The 5 Men's teams and 5 Women's teams with the best time amongst all the 4 x 500m Team Relay events (Event T01-T16) will qualify to compete for the "Top of the Tops President Cup" which shall be the last event on Sunday.
- 2. The winning team, both Men's and Women's, will be awarded a Trophy and Medals.
- Each competitor taking part in the PRESIDENT CUP will be awarded an event T-shirt.

(2) FAMILY FUN RELAY - 2x250m

There are 2 categories in the Family Fun Relay 2x250m.

In each category, each of the two team members must be one of father, mother, son/brother, daughter/sister from the same family. Eligibility for the 2 Groups is:

- (1) Group A One adult age 18 or above, one child age 8-11.
- (2) Group B One adult age 18 or above, one child age 12-15.
- There are no gender restrictions for both Groups in the Family Fun Relay events.
- The first rower must row exactly 250m and then hand over to the second rower who must complete the next 250m.

(3) SECONDARY SCHOOLS EVENTS

Restricted to school students. All rowers in the Secondary School events must be current students of the school under whose name they are entered. For verification of identity, every competitor must present the latest school document bearing the student's photograph authenticated by the school (e.g. student handbook or school record card) or other proofs of identity at registration counter on the race day.

(4) GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS EVENTS

Restricted to Government Departments in Hong Kong. All rowers must be current employees of the Government Department in whose name they are entered. Members of the Disciplined Services should enter the Disciplined Services events and are not eligible to enter the Government Departments events.

(5) **DISCIPLINED SERVICES EVENTS**

Restricted to Disciplined Services. All rowers must be current employees of Disciplined Service in whose name they are entered - Hong Kong Police Force, Fire Services Department, Correctional Services Department, Immigration Department, Customs and Excise Department, Government Flying Service.

(6) YOUTH ORGANIZATIONS EVENTS

Restricted to Youth Organizations. All rowers must be current members of the Youth Organization in whose name they are entered. In case of any dispute as to the eligibility of any Youth Organization, the decision of the Organizing Committee shall be final.

(7) PROFESSIONAL BODIES EVENTS

Restricted to Professional Bodies. All rowers must be current members of the registered Professional Body in whose name they are entered. In case of any dispute as to the eligibility of any Professional Body, the decision of the Organizing Committee shall be final.

(8) CORPORATE EVENTS

Restricted to registered Companies. All rowers must be current employees of a company registered in Hong Kong in whose name they are entered.

(9) SPORTS CLUBS/SOCIETIES (GROUP A AND GROUP B)

- (i) Group A Restricted to Rowing, Canoe and Paddling Clubs/Societies.
- (ii) Group B Restricted to all other Sports Clubs/Societies. All rowers must be a current member of the Sports Clubs/Society registered under the Companies or Societies Ordinance in whose name they are entered.

(10) PARA EVENTS

The sport classes PR3, PR2, and PR1 are based on the related Rules and Para Regulations of World Rowing.

- (1) Sport class PR3 includes physical impairments and visual impairments.
- (2) In the PR3 Mixed Four event, a maximum of 2 visually impaired rowers may be included in a team.
- (3) The PR3 (II) event, is restricted to rowers with intellectual impairment.

NOTE: Documentary proof of impairment (e.g., Registration Card for People with Disabilities/ medical certificates/ other relevant documents) should be submitted to hkric@rowing.org.hk on or before 1 February 2024. Any competitors who are unable to confirm their sport class should contact HKCRA before submitting their entry.

(11) HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS CHALLENGE

Restricted to Higher Education Institutions. All rowers must be current full-time students of the degreeawarding higher education institution in whose name they are entered. For verification of identity, every competitor must present a valid Student Identity Card at registration counter on the race day. Education https://www.edb.gov.hk/en/edu-(Please refer the list from Bureau: system/postsecondary/local-higher-edu/institutions/index.html).

 Each Institution may only submit one application in each of the 7 Higher Education Challenge events.

Points shall be awarded as follows (Only applies to **Higher Education Institutions Challenge** events): A point scheme shall be used to determine the overall winner of the Higher Education Institutions Challenge based on the results of the 7 events.

7. CHARITY ROWATHON RACES

(1) MAXIMUM QUOTA PER EVENT: 24 Teams (On a first-come-first-served basis)

(2) RACE DESCRIPTION

- Open; Government Departments; Professional Bodies; Corporate Charity Rowathon
- The racing time is 30 minutes. The winner will be the team completing the longest distance.
- 2. Each Team must comprise a minimum of 6 and a maximum of 10 members, including at least 2 male and 2 female rowers.
- 3. Each Team member must row for at least 3 minutes continuously in each race. A team with less than 10 members should have up to 4 members to row twice (i.e., two 3-minute stages). No rower may row more than twice.
- (ii) Secondary Schools Charity Rowathon
- The racing time is 15 minutes. The winner will be the team completing the longest distance. 1.
- Each Team must comprise a minimum of 4 and a maximum of 6 members, including at least 2 2. male and 2 female members.
- 3. Each Team member must row for at least 2.5 minutes continuously in each race. A team with less than 6 members should have up to 2 members to row twice (i.e., two 2.5-minute stages). No rower may row more than twice.

(iii) **Integrated Charity Challenge**

- The Team must comprise 1 able-bodied rower and 1 rower with a disability (physical impairment 1. or visual impairment).
- 2. Each rower must row at the same time, each using their own individual rowing machines. The output of the two machines shall be computer-linked to show the average time of the two rowers.
- 3. The winner will be the Team which completes the 1000m race distance first, based on their average time.

(iv) Row Cup

- The Team must comprise 1 able-bodied rower & 1 rower with a disability (physical impairment or visual impairment). The OC shall select the team members from the pool with the objective of equality and fairness between teams. The OC's decision on selection for this event shall be final.
- 2. The rowers in each Team must row for 3 minutes at the same time using their own individual
- 3. The winning Team winner will be the Team completing the farthest total distance accumulated by the 2 rowers in the Team.

8. SUPPORTER/COACH FOR INDIVIDUAL EVENTS

- 1. Each competitor in an Individual Event is allowed to bring one Supporter/Coach (coach, teacher, parent, or friend, etc.) to accompany him/her into the Race Area and remain with the competitor during their race.
- 2. The Supporter/Coach should remain quiet before the race and should sit on the seat provided during the whole race. (If the race is a Para event, the Supporter/Coach can assist the competitor to prepare for the race, e.g., assist the para rower to sit on the rowing machine, install the seat and adjust the machine, etc.)
- 3. The Supporter/Coach can cheer/coach their rower during the race, but cannot touch the competitor or rowing machine or any other equipment.
- 4. Supporter/Coach must always obey the instructions of umpires and officials when they are in the Race Area. Failure to obey any such instructions will result in the Supporter/Coach having to leave the Race Area.

ENTRY PROCEDURE

(1) ENTRY FOR ALL NON-CHARITY EVENTS

- The registration period is from 14th January 2024 to 1st February 2024 inclusive.
- The entry must be made online: http://bit.ly/3HoiFjJ
- registration page also can be accessed through official website (http://www.rowing.org.hk/) of HKCRA.
- Every competitor must come in person to prove his/her age by presenting a valid identification document to the Registration Counter on the race day (e.g. passport or identity card). For the age-group events, the age of the competitor is taken on the day of racing. Entries that cannot be proven or do not meet the age requirements for the event will be disqualified and no refund of entry fee will be made.
- Payment Method Online payment only. Other payment methods not be accepted.

(3) ENTRY FOR SECONDARY SCHOOLS EVENTS ONLY

- Payment can be made by cash or by cheque.
 - Cash: Cash payment should be made in person at the HKCRA Jockey Club Sha Tin Rowing Centre during office hours.
 - Cheque: A crossed cheque made payable to "Hong Kong, China Rowing Association" can be sent to "Hong Kong, China Rowing Association, Jockey Club Sha Tin Rowing Centre, No. 27 Yuen Wo Road, Sha Tin, N.T." Please write "2024 HKRIC", school name, contact person, and telephone number on the back of the cheque. (Please state "2024 HKRIC" on the envelope.)

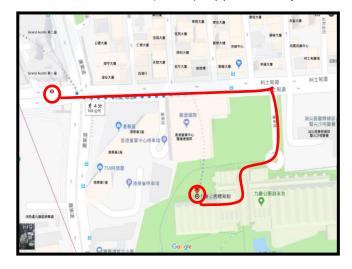
